1	FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to increase the tax on certain alcoholic beverages and to	
2	distribute the revenue.	
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:	
4	Section 1. That chapter 35-5 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:	
5	In addition to the tax imposed by §§ 35-5-3 and 35-12-7, a tax is imposed on wholesalers	
6	and manufacturers of alcoholic beverages, including farm wineries licensed pursuant to chapter	
7	35-12 and artisan distillers licensed pursuant to chapter 35-13, based upon the quantities of	
8	alcoholic beverages purchased, received, imported, or manufactured, as follows:	
9	(1)	Malt beverages, fifty-three cents per gallon or pro rata portion thereof;
10	(2)	All wines, ciders, and diluted beverages, one dollar and twenty-seven cents per gallon
11		or pro rata portion thereof; and
12	(3)	All other alcoholic beverages not otherwise specified, four dollars and twenty-seven
13		cents per gallon or pro rata portion thereof.
14	The term, diluted beverage, has the same meaning as provided in § 35-5-3.	
15	Section 2. That chapter 35-5 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:	
16	The tax imposed by this Act shall be administered and collected in the same manner as	

- 1 provided in this chapter for the collection of the occupational tax.
- 2 Section 3. That chapter 35-5 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- There is hereby created in the state treasury the local government alcoholic beverage fund.
- 4 The secretary shall deposit the revenue from the tax imposed by section 1 of this Act into the
- 5 local government alcoholic beverage fund.
- 6 Section 4. That chapter 35-5 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- Fifty percent of the revenue deposited in the local government alcoholic beverage fund shall
- 8 revert to the municipalities. Each municipality's share of the fund shall be determined by the
- 9 ratio of the population of each municipality to the total population of all the municipalities
- sharing in the receipts. The department shall make the reversion by remitting not later than
- November first, February first, May first, and August first, of each year to the finance officer
- of each municipality its share of the fund. The amount received by each municipality shall be
- deposited in the municipality's general fund.
- Section 5. That chapter 35-5 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- Fifty percent of all of the revenues deposited in the local government alcoholic beverage
- 16 fund shall revert to the counties. Twenty-five percent of the revenues distributed to counties
- shall be divided equally by all counties. The remaining seventy-five percent of the revenue shall
- be allocated to counties by the ratio of the population of each county to the total population of
- 19 all the counties sharing in the receipts. The department shall make the reversion by remitting
- 20 not later than November first, February first, May first, and August first, of each year to the
- 21 county auditor of each county its share of the fund. The amount received by each county shall
- 22 be deposited in the county's general fund.
